1. This is the first screen you see when you open the Beanstack Tracker app. Tap "Let's Go!"



2. Tap "School, Library, or Bookstore."



3. Tap "Find a Site."



4. Search for GADML or Grace A. Dow Memorial Library. *Most other searches* 



5. Tap "Grace A. Dow Memorial Library."



6. Returning users: Log in. New users: Tap "Sign up!"



7. Pick a username and a password.



8. Enter the account holder's first and last names. For kids, this should be their parent or other adult.

9. Enter email, phone number, and (optional) ZIP.

11. Tap "Fill out my Reader Profile."



12. Enter your first and last name and your age (this helps find challenges you are eligible for).



13. Add an profile picture (optional), or just tap "Continue."



14. Tap "Continue."



15. If you have family members to register, tap "Add Another Reader." Otherwise, tap "I'm done adding readers."

1. Summer Reading challenges are separated by age. Tap the initials in the upper corner to select a reader.



2. Tap the circle to select which reader you are registering for a challenge.



3. Tap "Discover."


4. Scroll down to 5. Select a school and grade level for the reader — or choose "Adult." Tap Register.

## beanstack Logging Reading in the App



1. Tap the + in the bottom center of the screen.



2. Tap "Reading." (OR Tap "Activity" to log an activity in the Children's or Teen challenges.)



3. Tap the empty 4. Tap "Choose circle next to the Reader." reader for whom you are logging.





5. Tap into "Search Title, Author, or ISBN" and enter information about the book you are logging. Tap the blue "search" button. (Alternately, you can log without a title by tapping that button.)



6. Tap the book cover. If it doesn't find the book, cancel and log without a title.



7. Tap "Quick Complete" to log reading for today. Tap "Log Reading"



8. If you tapped "Log reading," select the date and whether you finished the book. Your screen should say "Reading will count for to change the date. 1 challenge." Tap "Done."



9. You will get a message saying you have successfully logged your reading!

10. After you have logged your reading, you may also get a message saying you earned tickets. To spend your tickets in drawings, tap "View Challenge," and then "Drawings."
